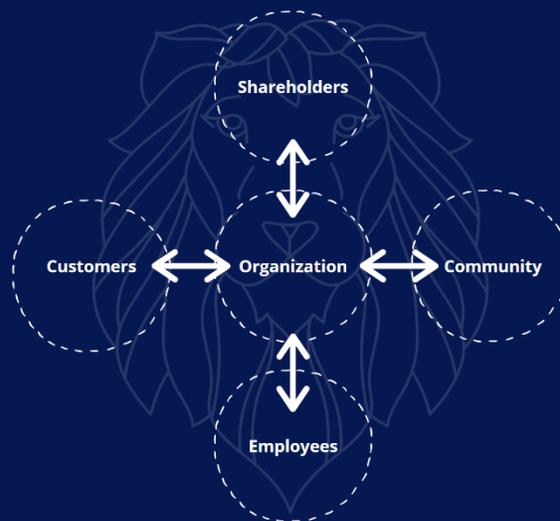


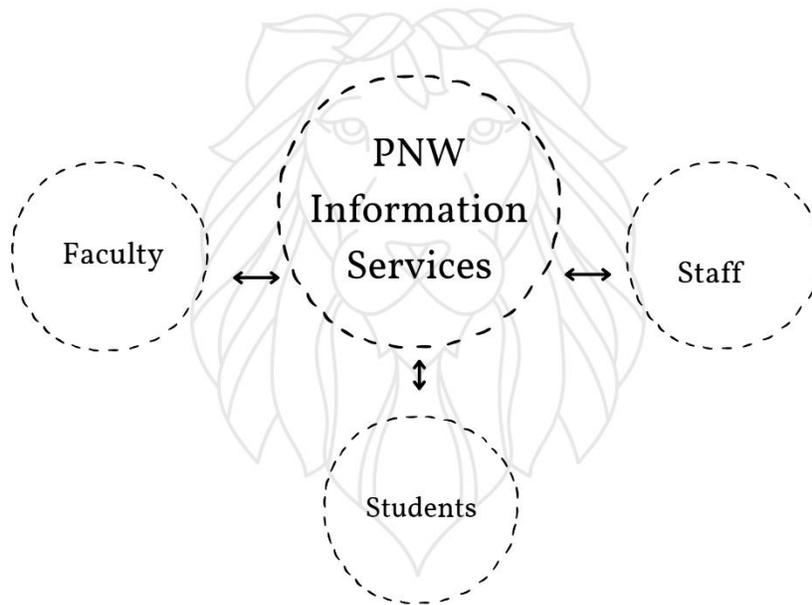
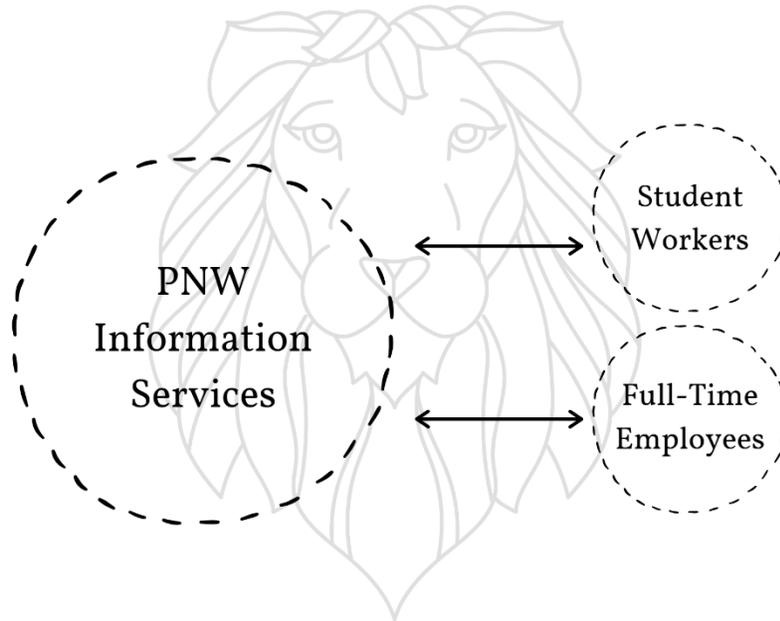
# Systems Theory

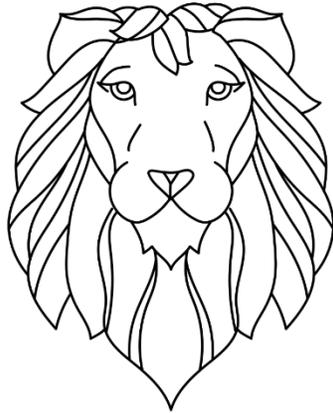
Systems theory is the interdisciplinary study of systems, and how they work. In public relations, systems theory states an organization is a part of a system consisting of three parts.

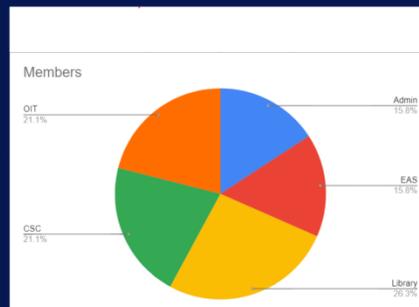
# Interviews



## Internal Interview Methodology

### Sorting Data

- Compiled list of employees
- Separated employees by department



### Unbiased Selection

- Assigned each employee in each department a number
- RNG used to select required amount of interviews

Interviews Conducted:

Admin = 3    Library = 5  
EAS = 3    OIT = 4  
CSC = 4

1. Obtained list of employees

2. Randomized & stratified list for total number of focus groups

3. RNG was used to assign employees to focus groups

4. Focus groups were successfully conducted

5. Participants were contacted

6. Separated directors from employees
